CBSE Communications:

The most significant recommendation made by the Board with effect from the year 2017-2018 is the revised assessment pattern for class VI-X. As per the Board's directive from this academic year all students of class X has appeared for the Board Exam. The CBSE conducts class X examination for 80 marks in each of the subject covering 100% of the syllabus. 20% of the weightage in each of the subjects are assessed by the school based on the continuous assessment during the academic year.
